IMPACT BY THE NUMBERS

In 2021, despite the ongoing pandemic, TGFT girls impacted 8,161 young people in Outreach Programs

In 2020, TGFT girls impacted 3,000+ young people in Outreach Programs

This year, 25 girls are enrolled in our Sponsorship Program.

Currently, 3 alumnae are employed. Two teach at private secondary schools and one is TGFT's Program Officer.

2021 Annual Appeal

Our TGFT team in Tanzania remained resilient and focused throughout 2021. The challenges presented by the relentless pandemic are very real, yet we are not detracted from our unwavering commitment to the core mission of TGFT: to support and educate motivated Tanzanian girls in need.

This year, we proved again that we can develop highly effective peer-to-peer mentoring and increased engagement for our girls. Estahappy and her staff model confidence and leadership every day, and the results are inspiring. We are well-positioned for continued impact in 2022 and beyond!

We have much to be proud of this year, from the academic success of our 25 core Sponsorship students to our 6 Peer Advocates whose work impacted over 8,000 young adults during their 6-month Gap Program between O and A levels. The team redesigned our Pre-Form One Residency Program for the 4 new students. TGFT's university students stepped into teacher's roles to enhance skills in math, English, computer, time management and adolescent health for the newcomers at The Girls Center for 2 months. This preparation is invaluable and essential in today's highly competitive environment for girls in Tanzania. TGFT girls initiated The Girls Fund at a local government secondary school. Our Peer Advocates mentored and trained students in life skills and menstrual health so they can initiate and lead their own health club. We believe that this outreach has great potential for further expansion.

The powerful ripple effect that our student-led projects and peer mentorships have had throughout the local community is especially rewarding for the team. As they inform and inspire a network of peers, the TGFT promise is authentic and measurable. TGFT is a family that encompasses many friends and supporters around the world. Our budget is limited, but our ambitions are high! In measures large and small, YOU make our mission possible.
