Who we are

We are a **community-led organization** committed to learning, mentoring, volunteering, and transforming lives. We are **educating 100 high-achieving girls** from underserved communities by providing full scholarships, leadership training, and academic support from secondary school through university.

We have **educated 252 girls in our Sponsorship and Scholarship Programs** to date.

Our Programs

Sponsorship Program: Through our Sponsorship Program **we partner with each student for 10 years**, from secondary school through university or medical school. We provide tuition, school supplies, personal hygiene, transportation, internships, and health coverage, and trainings for **33 girls** at **The Girls Centre**.

Scholarship Program: We provide merit + needs-based scholarships to **67 girls** to complete their secondary school education. Scholarships include tuition, hostel fees, school supplies, personal hygiene, and access to weekly club meetings both at school and at **The Girls Center**.

The Girls Centre - A beacon of hope

In January 2025 we completed construction of our new home campus and moved in. We trained 10 staff and 70 students on restorative agriculture and permaculture by EARN. We planted **720+ trees** and started organic vegetable gardens, which has reduced our food costs by 20%.

Our model goes beyond funding for girls to attend school. We believe girls need a community of like-minded ambitious girls, a place to belong to where they feel the support of others. We model lifelong learning by supporting our students in every role they play-as advocates, coaches, and mentors.

Community Outreach Program:

- Peer Advocates trained **7,007 students** (girls and boys) at 12 schools.
- Next Steps Program & College Guidance programs trained **543** high school graduates.
- School Clubs were conducted at 4 local government under-resourced schools. **9 Clubs** impacted **1,484 students** (Environmental Conservation, Girls' Health, Mentorship, and Soccer).
- After-School Program trained **50 primary school students**.
- *Coaches Across Continents*: 4 staff conducted SRHR, GBV and life skills sessions for **252 community members** using CAC's 'purposeful play' through sport.

To date TGFT has reached over **56,000+ youth and community members**.

Looking ahead to **2026** we plan to develop more learning opportunities, trainings and workshops for those we serve in our community.
